



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

Q | What days are practice days?

A | Practice days are usually Mondays and Wednesdays from 6pm – 8pm (8:30pm for Gold Squad). This is for Football Season only. Competition practices will be decided at a later date.

Q | What is the difference between Green Squad and Gold Squad?

A | Green Squad is 2nd – 5th graders and Gold Squad is 6th – 8th graders. Squads are based on what grade athletes will be going into come next school year.

Q | Is RPYC a non-profit?

A | Yes, RPYC is a class A non-profit program. All coaches and board members are volunteers.

Q | How long is a season?

A | Football season (for us) starts in late June and ends at the end of October. Football games are every Saturday (typically morning) beginning in September. Competition season begins immediately after Football Season and goes until mid February.

Q | Are there tryouts to make the team?

A | For Football Season, no, there are no try outs. Competition Season does have try outs.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

Q | How much is the registration fee?

A | Registration fees are \$250. These fees go toward insurance, practice space, equipment, state fees, association fees, team bonding events and continuing education for coaches.

Q | How much are the uniforms?

A | We have a package deal for uniforms. The package is \$500 and includes 3 practice shirts, 3 practice shorts, 3 practice bows, 1 cheer uniform, a set of poms and personalized back pack.

Q | Do you offer scholarships?

A | Yes, RPYC offers scholarships for those who need help paying fees. RPYC does all their own fundraising and is limited to how many scholarships we can give, based on how much we raise.

Q | How can I help RPYC raise funds?

A | You can help by hosting fundraising events with us, asking friends, family, and businesses for donations or to become a sponsor, and by spreading awareness about our program and what we offer for our teams as a youth sport.

Q | Can my athlete just do Competition and not Football Season?

A | No. Football season is required to be a part of Comp season. Comp is not required.

Q | Do you have a payment plan for fees?

A | As of right now, we do not. The board is working on setting up payment plans this year.

Q | How do you deal with bullying?

A | RPYC has a ZERO tolerance for bullying. We understand school aged kids will bicker often, but blatant bullying, racism, and harassment will result in termination from the team.

Q | Is RPYC affiliated with any other sports?

A | Yes. Rex Putnam Youth Cheer is affiliated with Rex Putnam Youth Football. Both non-profits are run by volunteer members.
